



Situate on the South side of Juniata river and on the East side of Sideling Hill, including an improvement in Springfield township and County of Huntingdon containing one hundred and two acres and eighty nine perches and the usual allowance of 6 ft. for roads &. Surveyed for John Hampson on 1<sup>st</sup> of Sep<sup>r</sup> 1794 in pursuance of a warrant dated the 14<sup>th</sup> of April 1794.
