



Situate in Tyrone township in the County of Huntingdon on the waters of the Frankstown branch of Juniata containing Four hundred & eleven acres twenty eight perchess and the usual allowance for roads resurveyed the 31st day of July 1801. In pursuance of an order of the Board to me directed dated the 29th day of December 1793.

Note a survey was made on the above land and returned to the Surveyor Generals Office on the 25th day of March 1765 for 302^{as} 51^{ps} on William Strawbridge warrant dated the 5th day of June 1762 which by the resurvey is found to be 411^{as} 28^{ps} as above.
