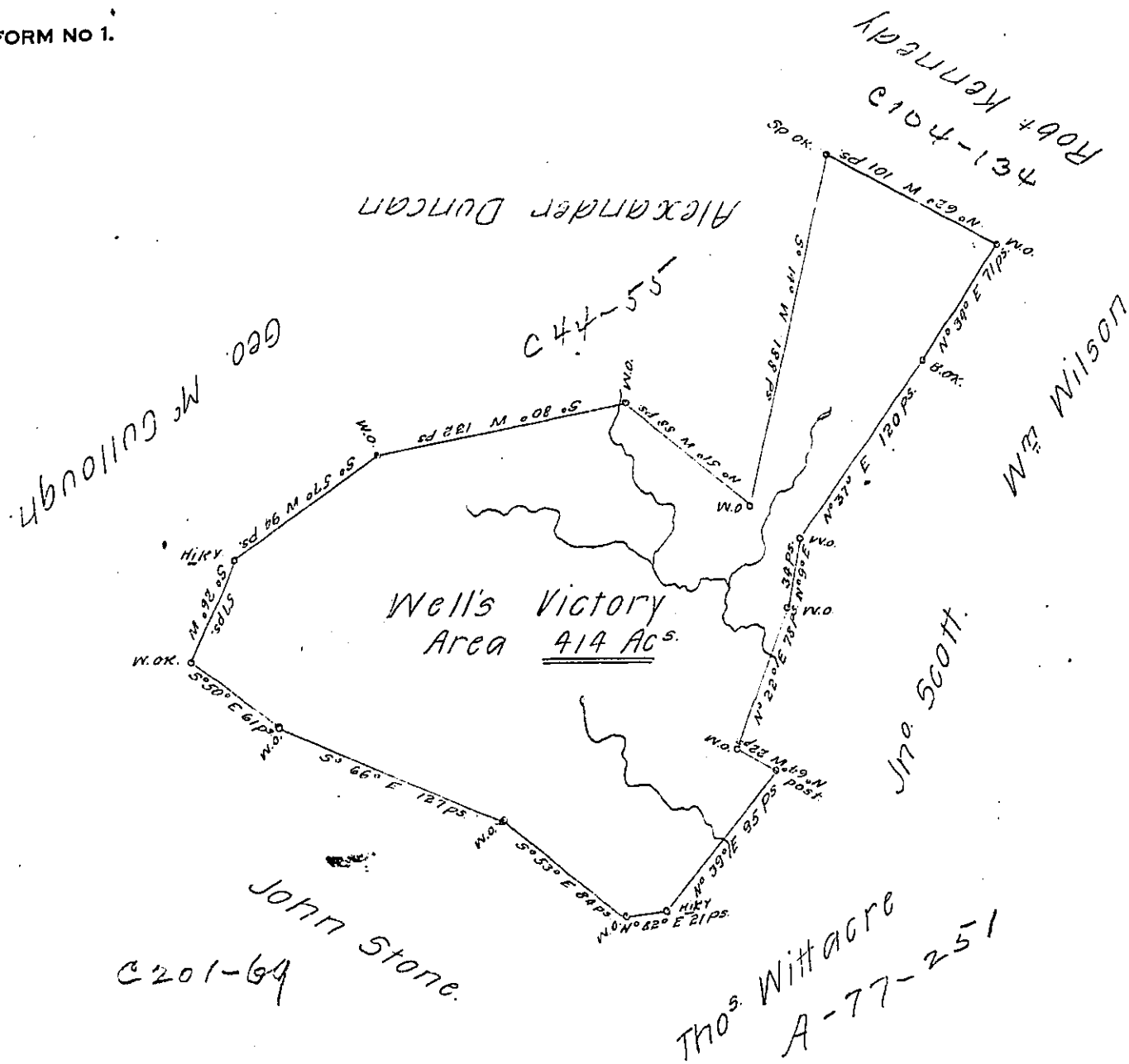

A draught of land called "Wells Victory" situate on the waters of Raccoon Ck. in Washington County, Cont<sup>g</sup> 414 Ac<sup>s</sup> strict measure executed M<sup>ch</sup> y<sup>e</sup> 30<sup>th</sup> 1786 in pursuance of a certif<sup>t</sup> for 400 Ac<sup>s</sup> granted to Geo. McCormick Ass<sup>ee</sup> of Benj<sup>n</sup> Wells (afterwards conveyed back to s<sup>d</sup> Wells) by the commiss<sup>rs</sup> appointed by Virg<sup>a</sup> to adjust the Claims to unpatented Lands in the counties Monong<sup>a</sup>, York<sup>a</sup> and Ohio, and duly entered with the County sur<sup>v</sup> as appears from the list of entries transmitted from y<sup>e</sup> Surv Gen<sup>l</sup> Office.
