



Situate in Manheim Township in the County of York Containing as above set forth 89 & 34 perches and allowance &c. Being part of a larger Tract of 239 & 135 perches and allowance of Land which was Originally Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to John Snyder bearing date the 25th day of September, A.D., 1785. Resurveyed by the old lines and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land on the 9th day of April, A.D., 1812, for and at the request of the administrators of Frances Heim deceased, for the use of George Heim, at whose request the same is now Returned the second day of May - A.D., 1814.
