



Situate in the Township and County of Huntingdon about a mile above the Town of Huntingdon on the opposite side of the Juniatta River surveyed the 20<sup>th</sup> day of August 1787 in pursuance of a warrant dated the 25<sup>th</sup> day of November 1786. Containing one hundred and sixty four acres one hundred and eighteen Perches and the usual allowance for Roads &c.
