



The above is a draught of a tract of land surveyed May 21st 1816, in pursuance of a warrant granted to William Sutherland dated the 12th day of April 1786, situate on the waters - Harmans creek in Hanover township in Washington county; containing 163 acres & 16 perches with the usual Allowance - At the time of survey there were about 35 acres cleared - The improvement was first made nearly thirty years ago, and a constant resident settlement kept up ever since - I know of no adverse claim.
