



By virtue of a warrant dated the 13<sup>th</sup> December 1792 No 2830 there was surveyed the 25<sup>th</sup> August 1794 by W<sup>m</sup> P. Brady the former Deputy Surveyor) to Wilhem Willink Nicholas Van Staphorst Christian Van Eeghen Hendrick Vollenhoven and Rutger Jan Schimmelpenninck the above described Tract of eight hundred & eighty one acres & sixty three perches & allowance situate on the waters of Sandy Lick Creek in the late purchase District No 5 in the County of Lycoming A Copy of which remains in my Office
