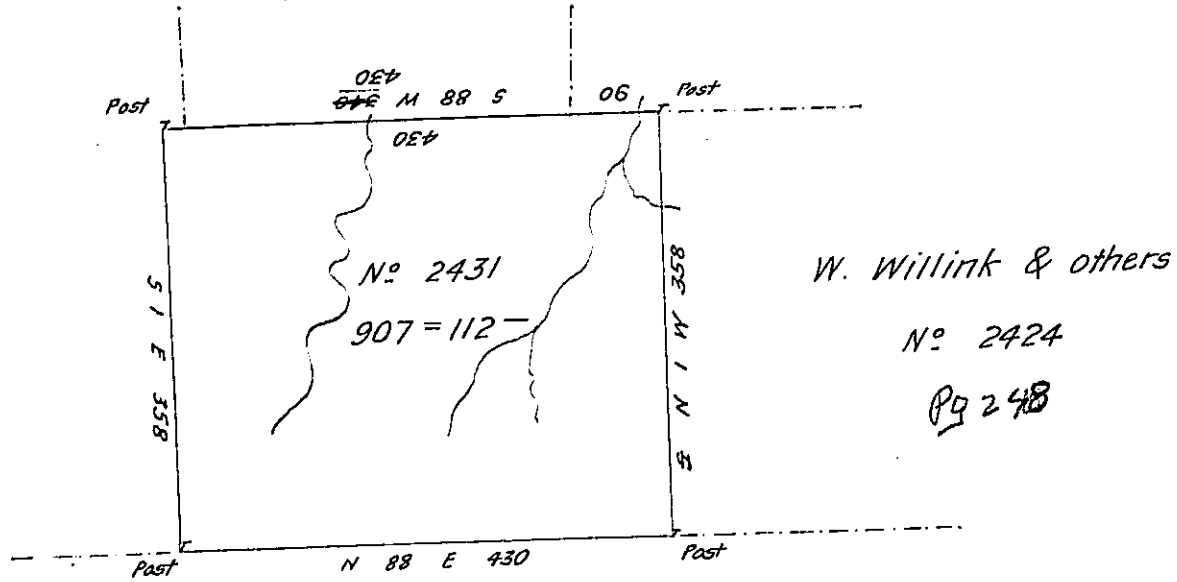

Brady (the former Deputy Surveyor) to Wilhem Willink Nicholas Van Staphorst Christian Van Eeghen, Hendrick Vollenhoven & Rutger Jan Schimmelpenninck the above described Tract of Nine hundred Seven acres & one hundred & twelve perches & allowance Situate on the waters of Stump Creek in District N^o 5 in the late purchase in the County of Lycoming - A Copy of which remains in my office.
