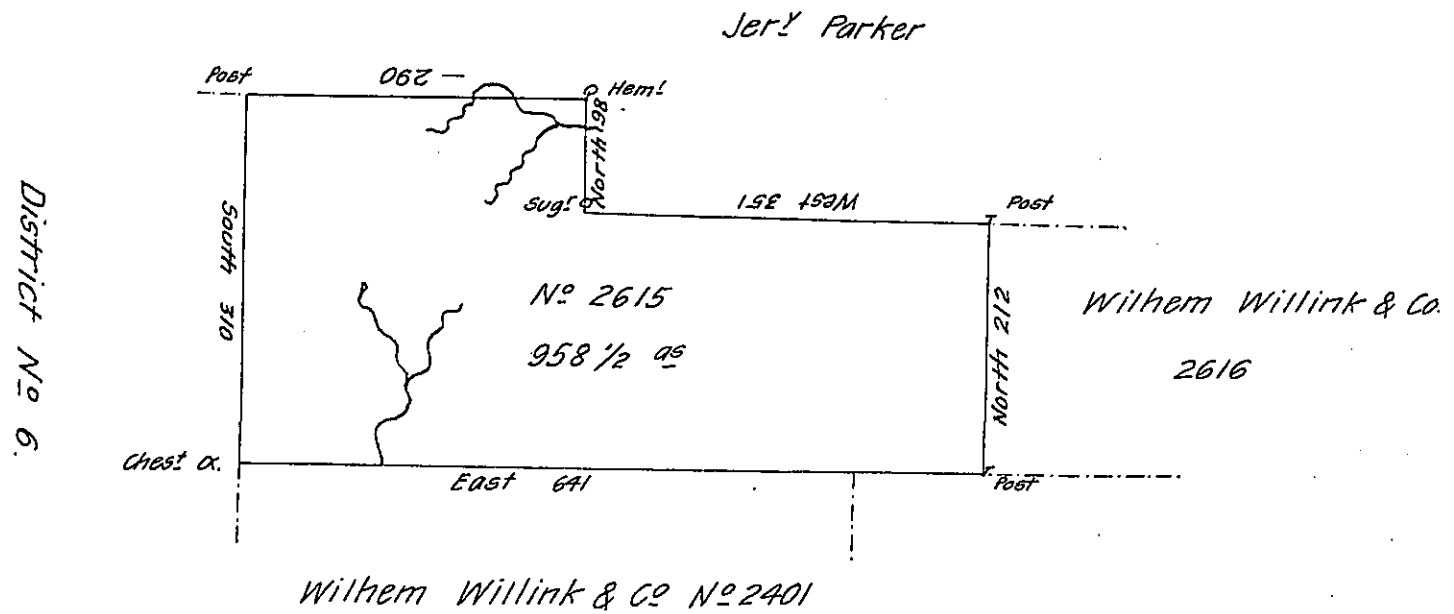

By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 12 December 1792 No 2615 there was surveyed the 27 August 1794 by Wm P Brady (the former Deputy Surveyor) to Wilhem Willink Nicholas Van Staphorst Christian Van Eeghen Hendrick Vollenhoven and Rutger Jan Schimmelpenninck the above described Tract of Nine hundred and fifty eight acres and an half & allowance situate on the waters of Sandy Lick Creek in District No 5 in the late purchase and County of Lycoming - a Copy of which remains in my office
