Containing three hundred ~~Acres~~ & thirty one Acres, Surveyed March the 5th. 1785 In pursuance of the hereto ennex'd Certificat= granted to Robert Taylor. We the Commissioners for adjusting the claims to unpatented Lands in the Counties of Monongahalea Yohogania & Ohio do hereby Certify that Robert Taylor is intitled to four hundred Acres of land in the County of Ohio situate on the Main fork of Buffaloe Creek to include his settlement made in the Year 1773 also a right in preemption to one thousand Acres adjoining thereto.

Given under our hands at Coxes fort the 11<sup>th</sup> Febr<sup>y</sup> 1780 & the fourth Year of the Commonwealth.
