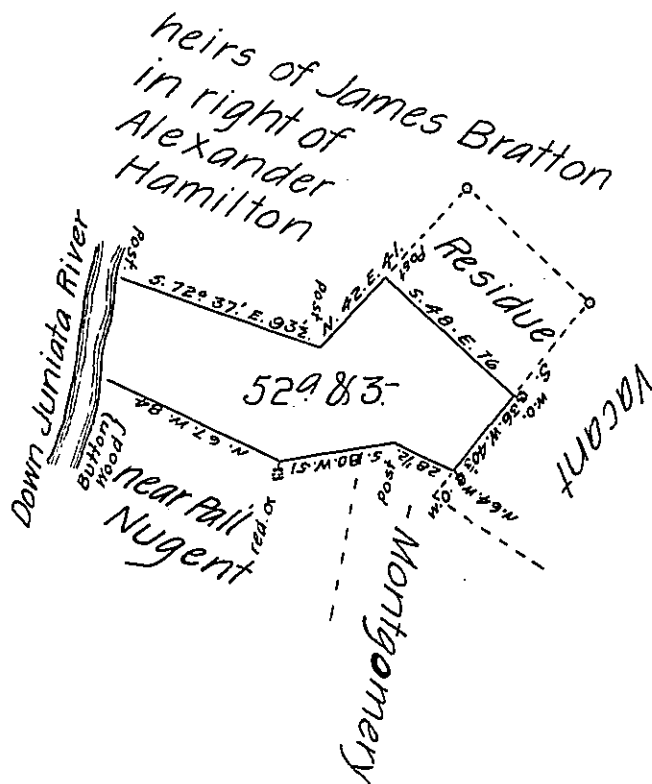


Course and distance

Said to contain 75^{ac} & 142 perches. Resurveyed the above part 11th Feb^y 1814.
