



The Draught of a tract of land Situate in Howard Township, Centre County. Containing three hundred and twenty four Acres, one hundred and fourteen perches and allowance of six per Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the 21<sup>st</sup> day of November 1817, in pursuance of a warrant granted to Fredrick Shenk dated the 17<sup>th</sup> day of June 1817.

The improvement on the above described tract of land, consists of a considerable quantity of cleared land, and two familys residing thereon, each having a Dwelling house and Stable. And agreeable to information was first improved in the month of October, in the year 1792.
