



Christian Wanger's Land between Conestogoe and the Mill Creek, Beginning at a Corner marked spanish oak at a Corner of John Line's Land thence S. by E. by Vacant Land 80 per. to a Black oak, thence West by Vacant Land 190 per. to a post, thence N. by West by Vacant Land 103 perches to a post, thence South 83 degrees, Easterly by the 5^d John Line's Land 195 perches to y^e Place of Beginning. Containing 100 acres with y^e usual Allowance of 6 P^r.C. Surveyd June 22^d 1721.
