



Rt from 1st March 1749.

A Plan of a Lot of Ground Situate on the West side of Beaver Street, in the Town of York, marked on the General Plan of the said Town Number 98, Containing in Breadth on Beaver Street aforesaid fifty seven Feet and six Inches, and in length to a Twenty Feet Alley, Two hundred and Fifty Feet. Bounded Eastward with Beaver Street aforesaid, Southward with a Lot of Ground marked on the General Plan of the said Town Number 99, Westward with a Twenty Feet Alley, and Northward with a Lot of Ground marked on the General Plan aforesaid Number 97. Surveyed for John Wall who has built an House thereon according to the Conditions of Settling the Town.

Certified at York the Second day of July 1761.
