



By Virtue of a Warrant Dated at Philadelphia on the 4th Day of April Anno-1747, granted to Jacob Wink The above described Tract of Land Situate on the East Side of Weissenburgh Township, near Jordan Creek, in the County of Northampton and Province of Pennsylvania.

Containing Fifty Three Acres and Ten Perches of Land together with the usual Allowance at Six per Cent for Roads. Was Surveyed for William Moyer on the 20th Day of August Anno-1754.
