



By Virtue of a Warrant dated 22^d May 1823, Surveyed the 4th day of March 1824 by John K. Woodward Esq^r the Deputy Surveyor of this district to Elijah Weston, the above described tract of land Situate partly in Lebanon and partly in Damascus Townships, Wayne County - Containing one hundred and thirty two acres, and one hundred and fifteen perches, with allowance of Six per Cent &c. - and including the greater part of a pond called "Equinunk Pond"

All which appears by the return of the late Deputy Surveyor, remaining in my keeping, which I have examined this 10th day of May 1825 and find to be correct.
