



The above is the Draught of a Survey made February 12th 1828 for John Warnock's Heirs on a Certain Tract of Land Situated on the East Side of the old path leading from Logstown to Rackoon about four miles from Logstown in formerly Washington County now Hopewell Township in Beaver County. Surveyed in pursuance of a grant to George Eberley from or under the proprietary Government for 300 Acres No 646 dated 3rd April 1769 and according to an Act of Assembly passed 22nd March 1820 & 25 & 26. The Survey Contains Three hundred eighteen Acres, Sixty three perches and allowance of Six per Cent for Roads &c.
