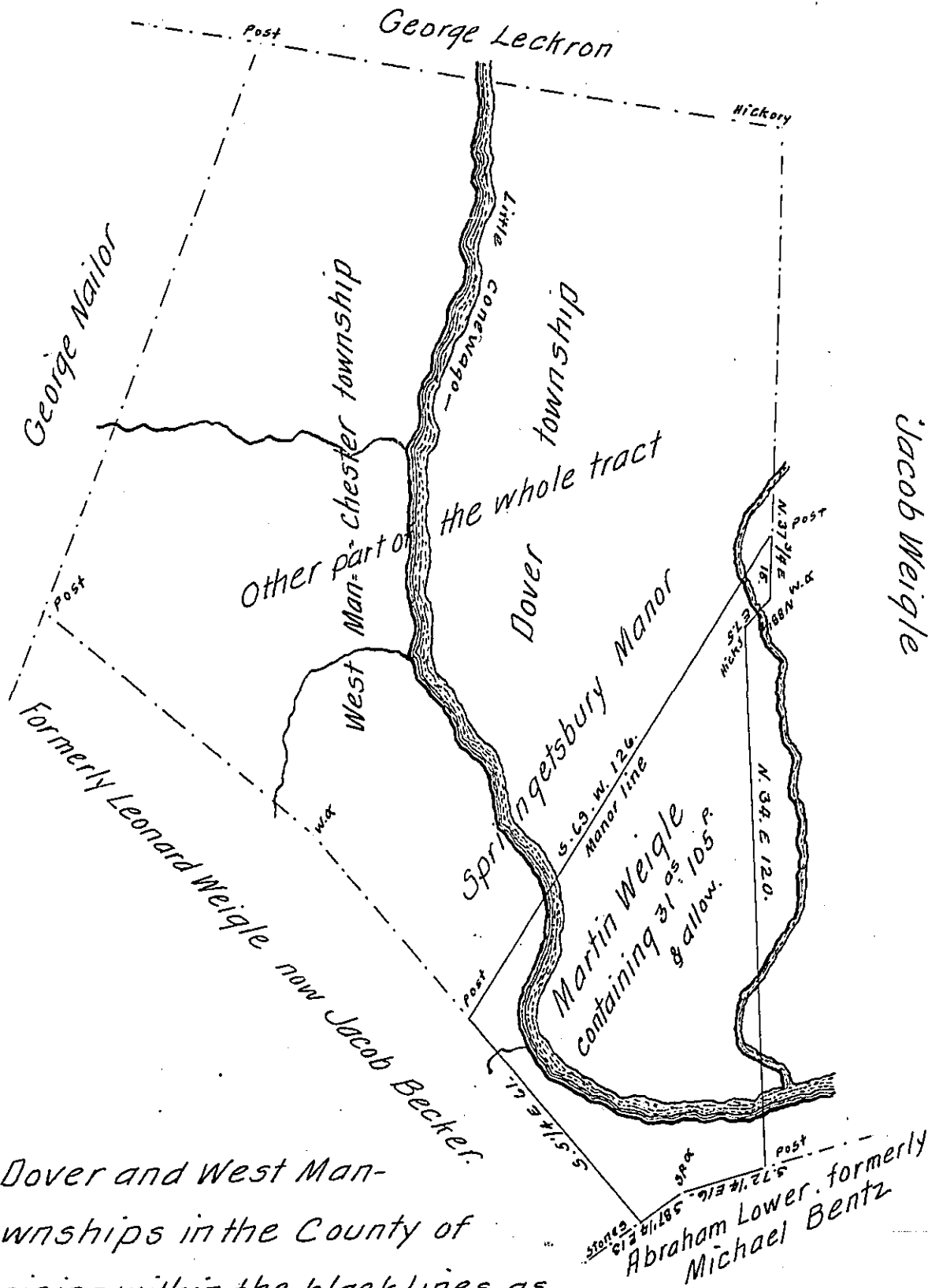


FORM NO. 1.



Situate in Dover and West Manchester townships in the County of York Containing within the black lines as above set forth 31^{as} 105 perches and allowance &c^a Being part of a larger tract of 167^{as} & 120^{ps} &c^a of Land which was Originally Surveyed in Pursuance of a Warrant granted to Martin Weigle bearing date the 27th day of April A.D. 1802. Divided off from said Larger tract the 25th day of May 1819. And now this 27th day of October A.D. 1827. the same is calculated, examined found correct, and at the request of the Rev^d John George Schmucker the same is returned for confirmation.
