



Situate on the south side of Dunning's Creek (formerly Bedford now) in St. Clair Township Bedford County, containing 103 acres 155 perches & allowance of 6 per cent for roads &c. Surveyed by J. W. Lingenfelter Esq. for Capt. George B. Wisegarver the 23rd. of August 1852 being part of of a tract that originally contained 200 acres &c. Surveyed on order No. 5175 granted to Jennett Dobson dated the 7th. of September 1768.

Returned the 25th. of September 1852 - To be patented to Capt. George B. Wisegarver - Courses - according to the true bearings.
