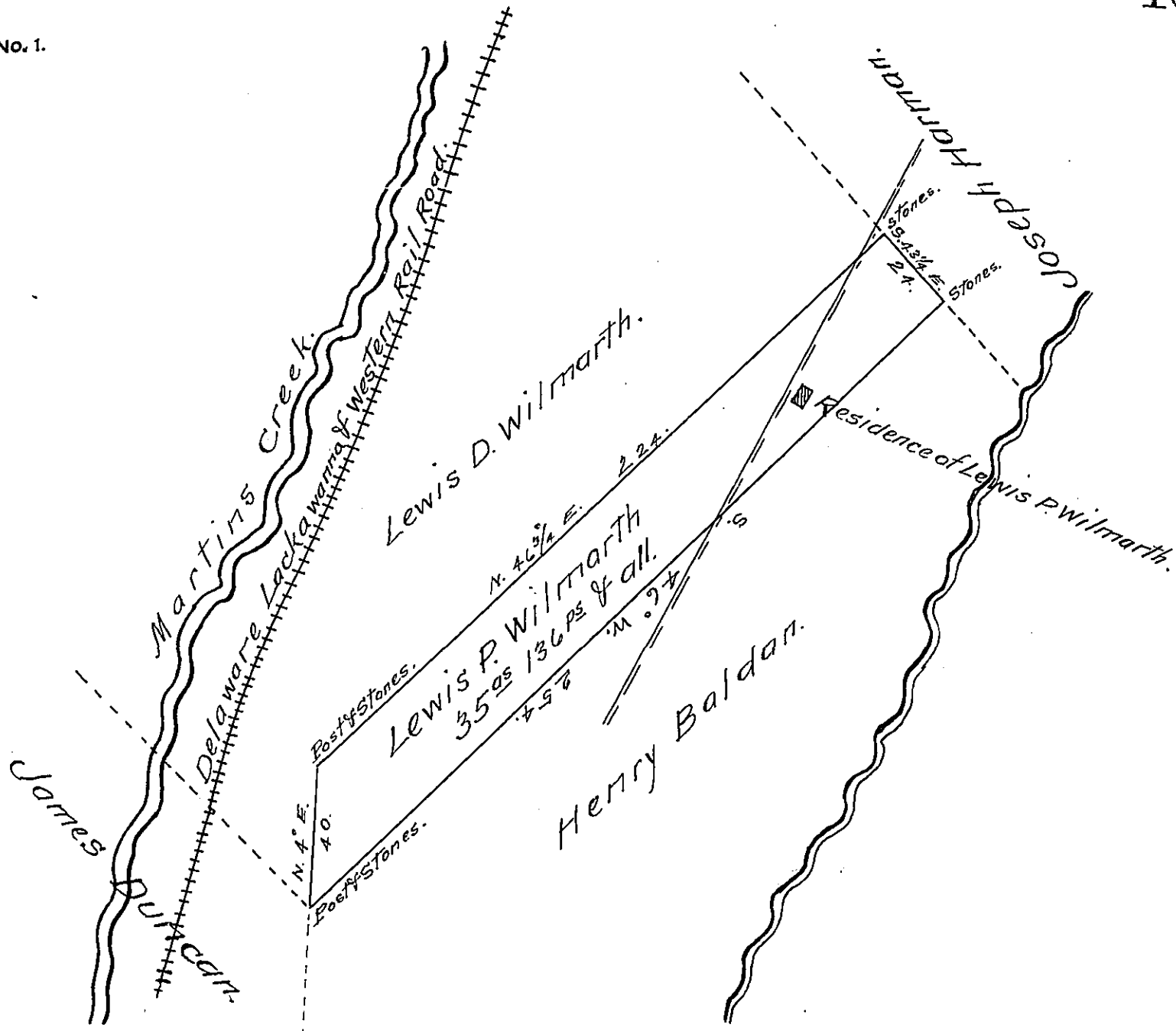

of his improvement warrant bearing date the sixth day of
December A. D. 1853 Containing thirty five acres and one hun-
dred and thirty six perches and the allowance of six per-
cent for roads &c.

Note - 30 acres and 152 perches of the above tract of land is claimed
by Crawford Titus - on which there is an improvement of about four
acres. with an unoccupied dwelling house - the property of Lewis
P. Wilmarth (so reported)
