I Have accordingly taken off 20 acres as appears in y<sup>e</sup> above Draught with the consent of Andreas Hersey & added to Michl. Weidles survey, which is as much as cou'd with any Conveniency be done. Notwithstanding which Michl. Weidles Son in Law Furnly is dissatisfy'd. with it & I suppose will make further complaint. But I think there's no reason to keep Andreas Hersey out of his Patent after the 20 acres herein laid down is taken off y<sup>e</sup> Draught of his Land now in y<sup>e</sup> office.
