



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Marlborough Township in the County of Philadelphia and Province of Pennsylvania Containing Forty Two Acres and 58 Perches of Land together with the usual Allowance at six per Cent. for Roads. — That formerly was Surveyed by Edward Scull unto Peter Haghener, in Pursuance of a Warrant granted to him By the Hon^{ble} Proprietaries Dated the 19th Day of May Anno-1747.

The said Peter Haghener assigned his Right to the same unto Leonard Alderfer on the 29th January 17⁴⁹/₅₀, who sold the same on the 22nd November 1751 unto John Martin Reyer, who again by his agreement Dated on the 11th July 1760 Sold his Right to the same unto Valentine Keyser, who also by his Agreement dated the 12th October Anno-1767 Sold the same unto Ludowick Hirsh - for whom it was Resurveyed on the 11th November Anno-1771.
