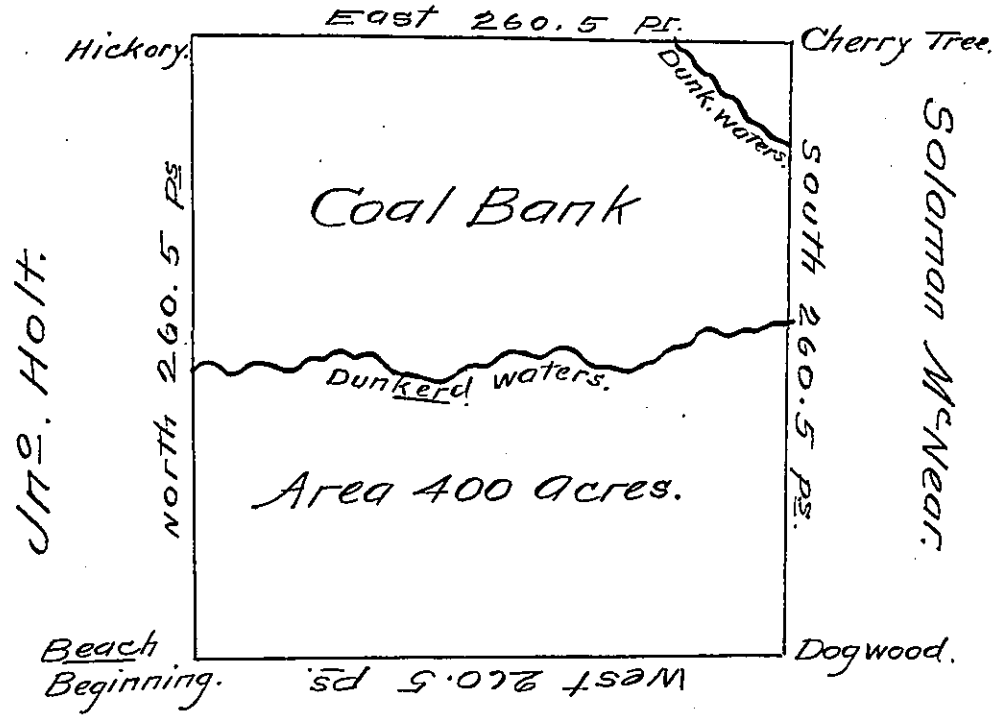


Prestley Blackston.
