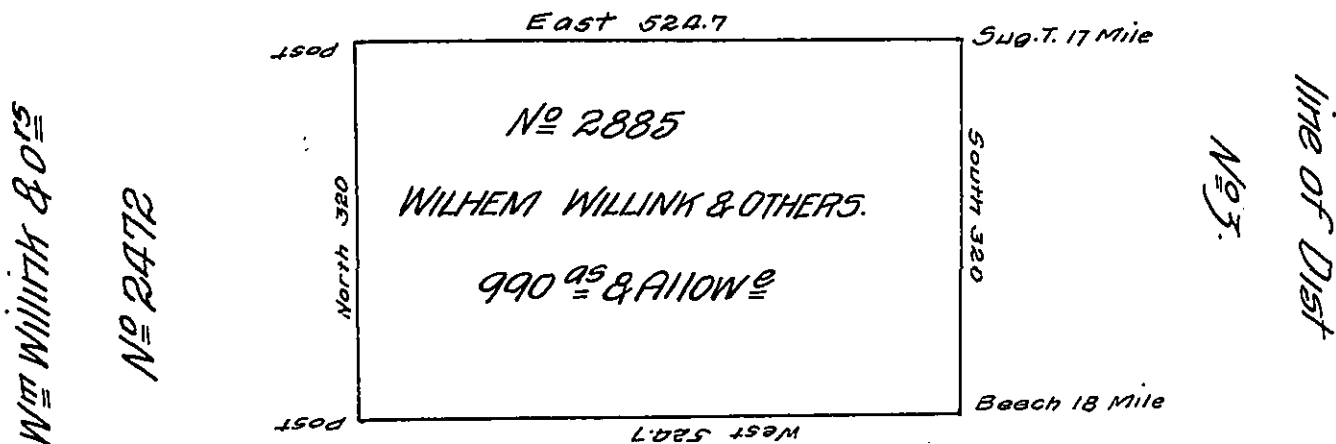

Joining the line of District No 3 from the 17 to the 18 Mile Tree in pursuance of a Warrant, to Wilhem Willink, Nicholaas Van Staphorst, Christiaan Van Eeghen, Hendrik Vollenhoven, & Frutger Jan Schimmelpenninck of Amsterdam Dated the thirteenth day of December 1792 for 900 A<sup>s</sup> Containing Nine hundred & Ninety A<sup>s</sup> & the Usual Allowance of Six pr. Ct. for Roads &c. For Daniel Brodhead Esq<sup>r</sup> S.G.
