

Surveyed on the Second Day of July 1793 Nine hundred and Ninety Acres of Land
with the allowance of six percent situate in District N^o. 6 in the late purchase on
the East side of the Allegany River; adjoining Wilhem Willink and others - N^o. 2821.
By Virtue of a Warrant to Wilhem Willink, Nicolaas Van Staphorst, Christian Van
Eeghen, Hendrick Vollenhoven, and Rutger Jan Schimmelplinnich of Amsterdam N^o
2822; dated the Thirteenth Day of December 1792.
