



Draft of a tract of land Situate in the township of Hanover in Luzerne County on the waters of Nescopeck adjoining lands of Daniel Vancamp and others - containing three hundred Ninety nine acres and twenty eight perches of land besides the usual allowance of six per Centum for roads &c - Surveyed for Rosannah Vancamp forty or forty one years ago as appears by blocking the line trees upon the ground - And Resurveyed the 7th day of May 1839 by virtue of her warrant dated the 8th day of January A^o D^o 1793.

N.B. The Red dotted lines shewes the interference of two Surveys one made the 7th March 1839 on warrant to John Brink dated the 13th day of Feb^y 1839 covering ^{about} four acres & fifty seven perches & all^o the other made the 28th Feby 1839 on warrant to Geo. W. Woodward dated the 24th Dec^r 1838 Covering about one acre eighty five perches & all^o.
