



Draft of a tract of unimproved land Situate in Scott township Wayne County adjoining land of David Caldwell, Elisha Courtright, Abraham Courtright and Henry Toland Beginning at a Beech the North West corner of Elisha Courtright thence North Eighty five and three quarters degrees West two hundred and twenty six rods to stones the South East corner of Henry Toland thence by land of Addison Weld (late ~~David Caldwell~~ Abraham Courtright) South five degrees West thirty nine and one tenth rods to stones thence South Eighty four and a half degrees East two hundred and twenty six rods to stones a North East corner of the land last aforesaid thence North five degrees East forty four rods to the beginning Containing fifty-five acres and fifty perches and Allowance of Six per cent—
