



The above diagram represents a part of a larger tract of land that I surveyed on the 6<sup>th</sup> of May 1837. In pursuance of a Warrant Granted in the name of Hugh J. Wassone Dated March 27<sup>th</sup> 1837, which said larger Survey contained three hundred and ninety two acres & Eighty perches & allowance of Six per cent. There was a caveat entered on the Return of Survey by Benjamin Leasure. The whole matter has since been compromised and the Warrantee H. J. Wasson on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of June 1845. conveyed the same to the said George Leasure above named, which I since resurveyed and find it all correct. Situate in Franklin Township Armstrong County N.W. of Allegheny River containing one hundred and ninety nine acres and ninety perches and allowance of Six per Cent & Resurveyed 6<sup>th</sup> Oct. 1845.
