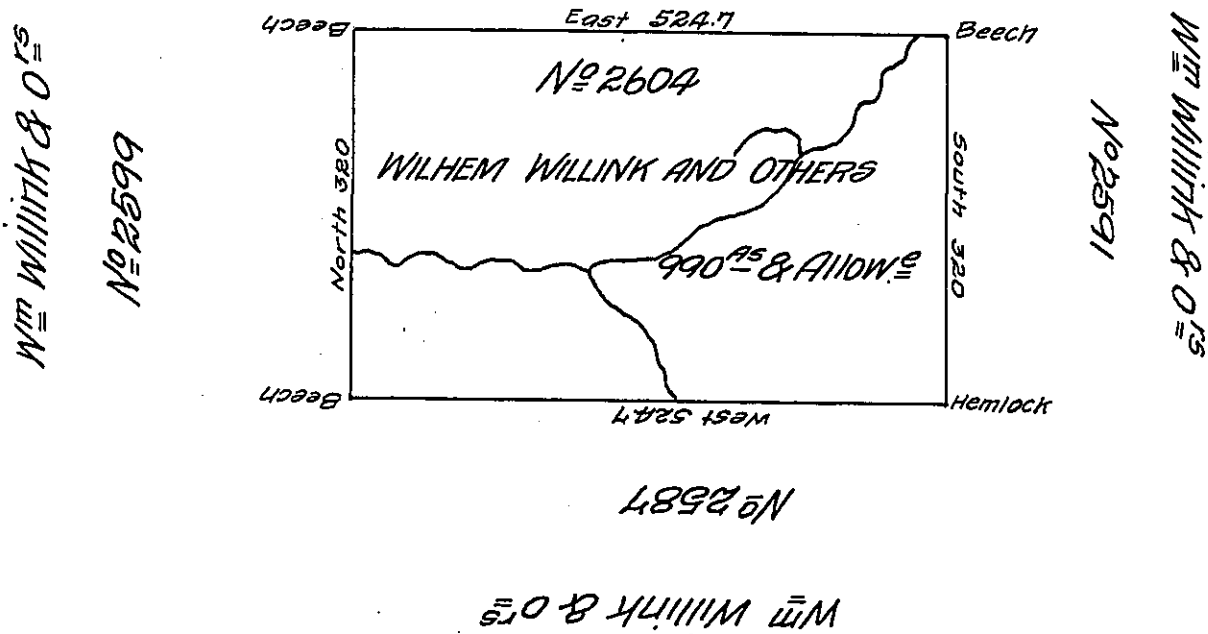


Wilhem Willink & O<sup>rs</sup>

Situate on the Waters of big Toby's Creek in the last purchase Dist No 4 about a Mile &  $\frac{3}{4}$  West of the thirty Mile Tree one the line of Dist No 3 Surveyed the Ninth day of July 1793. In pursuance of a Warrant No 2604 to Wilhem Willink, Nicholaas Van Staphorst, Christiaan Van Eeghen, Hendrik Vollenhoven & Rutger Jan Schimmelpenninck of Amsterdam Dated the twelfth day of ~~July~~<sup>Dec</sup> 1792 for 900 A<sup>s</sup> Containing Nine Hundred & Ninety A<sup>s</sup> and the Usual Allowance of Six pr. Ct. for Roads &c.
