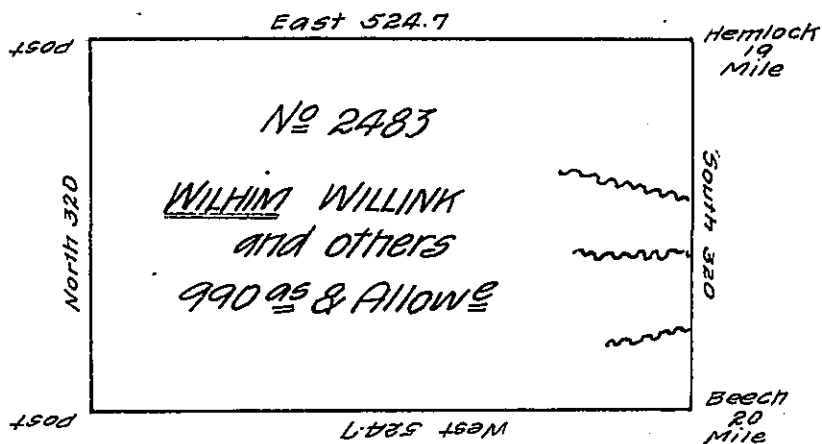

Ct for Roads &c. pr James Hunter D.S For Daniel Brodhead Esq^r S.G.
