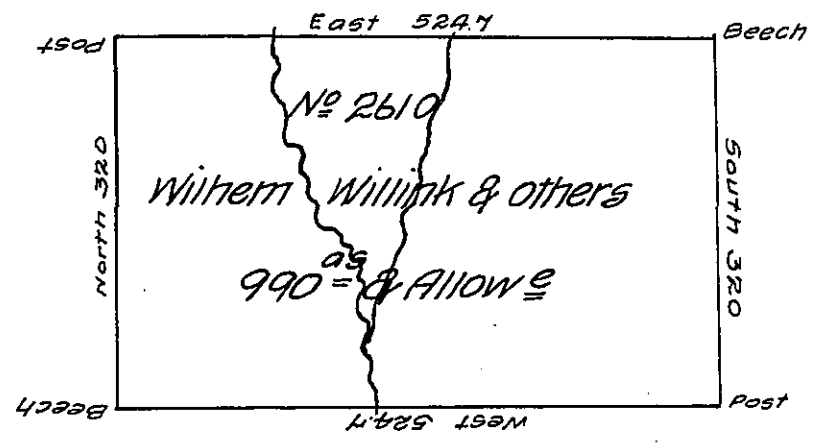

In pursuance of a Warrant N^o 2610 to Wilhem Willink, Nicholaas Van Staphorst, Christiaan Van Eeghen, Hendrick Vollenhoven and Rutger Jan Schimmelpenninck of Amsterdam, Dated the twelfth day of December 1793 for 900 A^s Containing Nine Hundred & Ninety A^s. & the Usual Allowance of Six pr. Ct^s for Roads &c.
