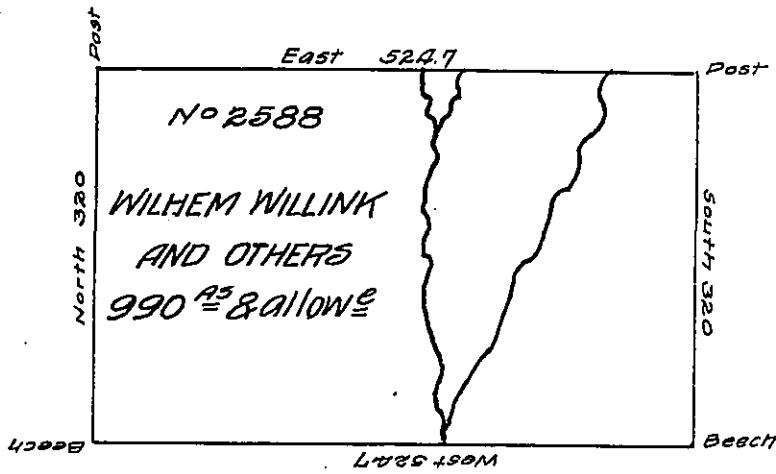

Situate about 2 Miles South of the black Swamp on the Waters of big Toby's Creek in the last Purchase District No 4 Surveyed the eleventh day of July 1793 In pursuance of a Warrant No 2588 to Wilhem Willink, Nicholaas Van Staphorst, Christiaan Van Eeghen, Hendrik Vollenhoven, & Rutger Jan Schimmelpenninck of Amsterdam. Dated the twelfth day of December 1792 for 900 Acres Containing Nine hundred & Ninety Acres & the Usual Allow^e of Six pr. Ct. for Roads &c.
