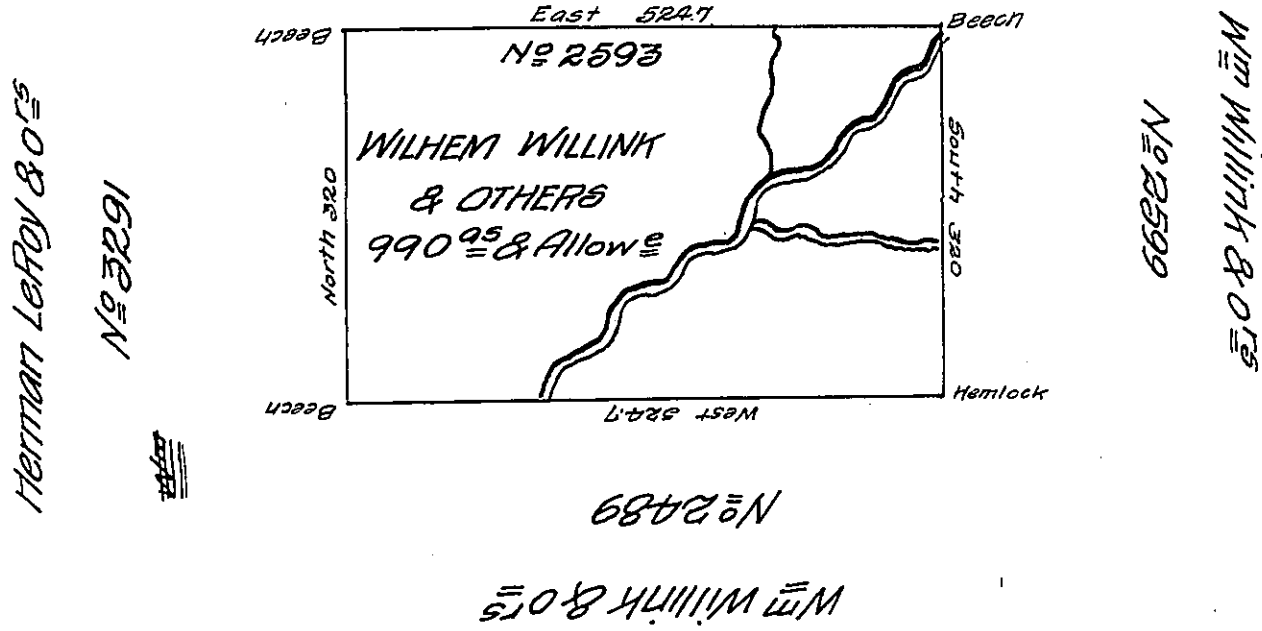


Wilhem Willink & O^{rs}

In pursuance of a Warrant No 2593 to Wilhem Willink, Nicholaas Van Staphorst, Christiaan Van Eeghen, Hendrik Vollenhoven & Rutger Jan Schimmelpenninck, of Amsterdam Dated the twelfth day of December 1792 for 900 A^s Contain- ing, Nine Hundred & Ninety A^s & the Usual Allowance of Six pr. Ct. for Roads &c.
