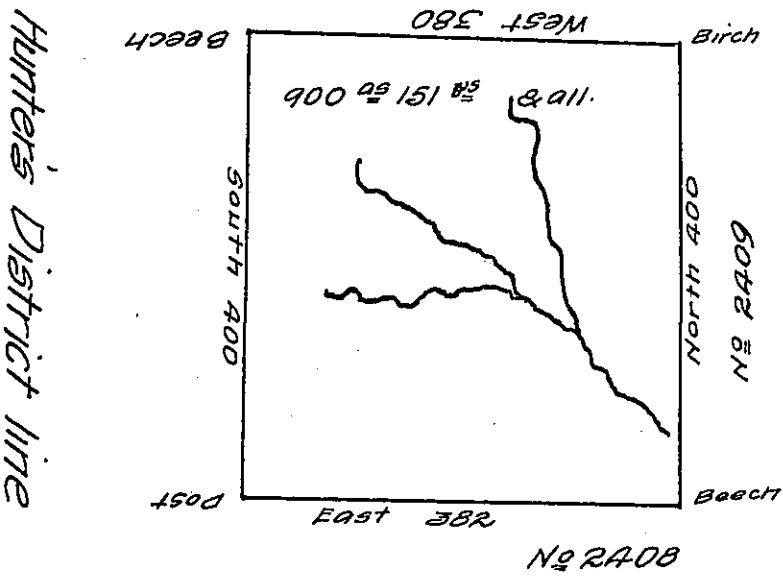

 Rutger San Schimmelpenninck in persewance of a Warrant
