



Situate in Peach Bottom township in the County of York Containing as above set forth 7^{2/3} and 3/4 perches with the usual allowance of six per cent for roads and Highways 40%. Originally Surveyed on the 11th day of June 1824 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to John Sample bearing date the 28th day of October 1815, And now this 5th day of July 1825 the same is examined, found to be correct, and at the request of James Johnson and John Kelly the present owners, returned for confirmation.
