



A draught of a tract of land situate in Oakland Township in the County of Berks and Province of Pennsylvania being the equal half part of a tract of 137 1/4 acres and the allowance that formerly was surveyed unto Lazarus Weidner by virtue of a warrant dated the 19th April Anno 1749 who after the patent is got out for the said whole tract is to convey the above whole tract unto his brother Tychicus Weidner. Beginning at a stone in the line of Abner Wickerstarns land thence by the same south 40 degrees west 40 perches to a stone. thence by the same and by land of Nicholas Leshel north 65^{degs} West 117 perches to a stone and by the same and Vaccant land North 50^{degs} West 110 perches to a stone thence by the said Vaccant land and by land of John Mull North 40^{degs} East 49 1/10 perches to a stone set for a corner of the said Lazarus Weidner's land thence by the same south 55 degrees and 15 minutes East 224 perches to the place of beginning containing sixty eight acres and one hundred perches of land together with the usual allowance at six per cent for roads or seventy two acres and 120 perches including the said allowance resurveyed and divided for the said Tychicus Weidner on the 16th October Anno 1771
