



A draught of a tract of land called — situate on the dividing waters of Muncy & Fishing Creeks & joining land surveyed for Martin Forster and others in Muncy Township & County of Northumberland surveyed on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of April 1785 for John Wilkinson by virtue of warrant bearing date the 16<sup>th</sup> day of February 1785 containing three hundred & two acres &  $\frac{3}{4}$  of an acre with allowance of six per cent for roads &c.
