



A draught of a tract of land situate in Oley Township in the County of Berks formerly in the County of Philadelphia and Province of Pennsylvania containing one hundred and twenty four acres and 28 perches of land together with the usual allowance at six per cent for roads that was now surveyed for George Wagner in pursuance of a warrant granted by the Hon^{ble} Proprietor of this Province unto John Arn Huffnail the said warrant is dated on the 16th January Anno 1733 The said warrant was on the 3rd April 1743 assigned by the said Huffnail (alias Arnold Huffnagel) to Conrad Reiff who again on the 4th May Anno 1771 assigned the same to the said George Wagner to whom it was now surveyed (though opposed by Philip Reiff) on the 19th June Anno 1775 by order of the Surveyor General
