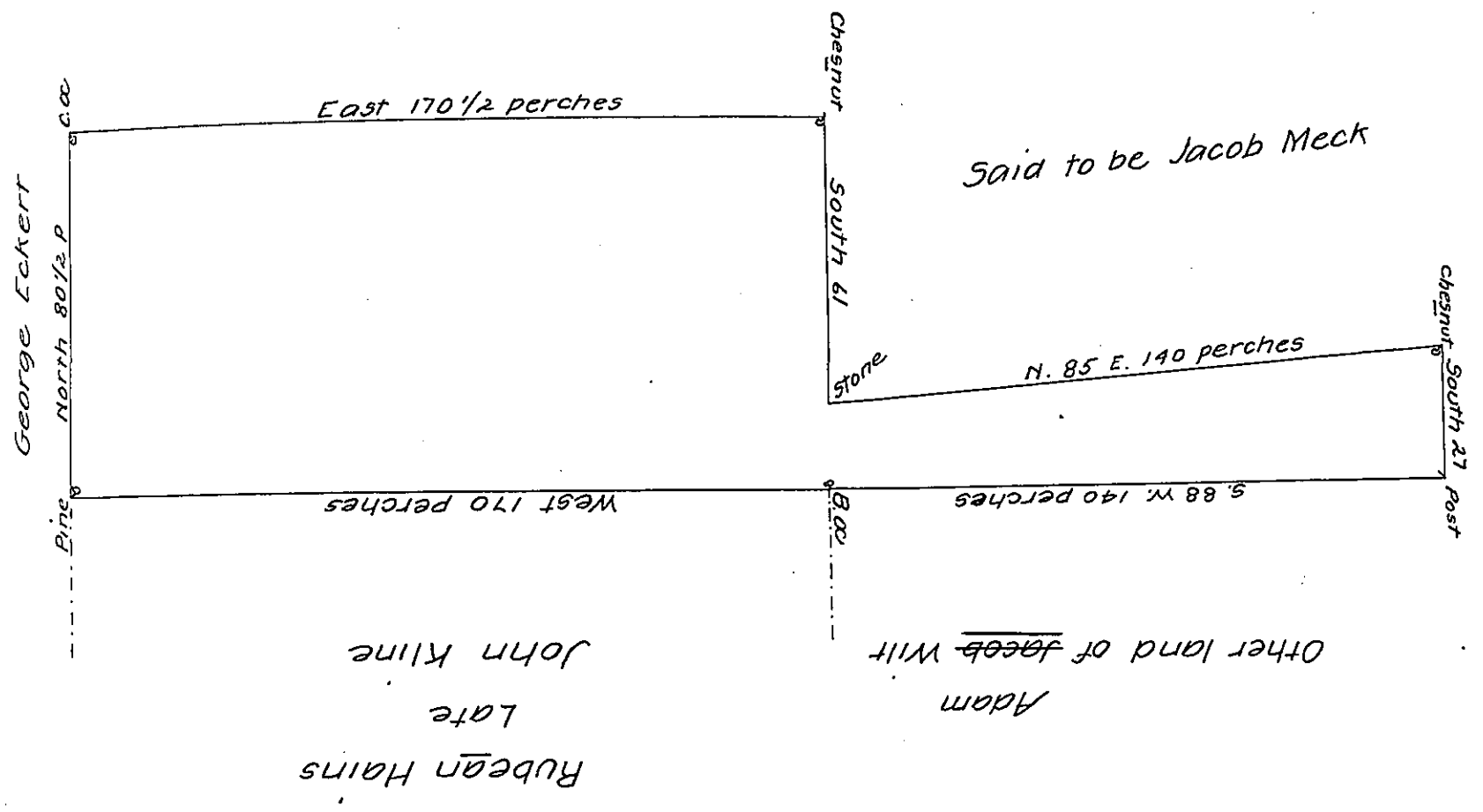


Vacant Mountain
