Being part of a larger tract of 212<sup>acs</sup> & 155<sup>Prs</sup> of Land which was originally Surveyed on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Mo<sup>o</sup> 1766 by William Matthews late D.S. for Jacob Weist Sen.<sup>r</sup> in pursuance of a warrant for 160<sup>acs</sup> bearing date the 8<sup>th</sup> day of October 1765. Resurveyed and Divided off from said larger tract on the 22<sup>d</sup> day of August 1809 at the request of William McClellan the present owner who desired me to make return of the Draught.
