


FORM NO. 1:



Surveyed on the twenty ninth Day of June 1793 nine hundred and ninety Acres of Land with the allowance of Six per Cent. Situate in District No 6 in the late purchase on the East side of the Allegany River; adjoining Wilhem Willink and others No 2492; by Virtue of a warrant to Wilhem Willink, Nicolaas Van Staphorst, Christian Van Eghen, Hendrick Vollenhoven, and Rutger Jan Schimmel-pinnick of Amsterdam No 2493; dated the Twelfth Day of December 1792.
