Situate in district No 6 in the late purchase on the East side of the Alleghany River; adjoining Wilhem Willink, and others No 2807; by Virtue of a Warrant to Wilhem Willink, Nicolaas Van Staphorst, Christiaan Van Eeghen, Hendrick Vollenhoven and Rutger Jan Schimmelpinninck of Amsterdam No 2810; dated the 13th. Day of December 1792.
