



Situate in Manheim township in the County of York containing as above set forth 26^{1/2} & 30 perches & allowance. Surveyed the 26th day of October Anno Domini 1813. in pursuance of a Warrant for 25^{1/2} granted to Jacob Wantz bearing date the 7th day of October A.D. 1813.

The Improvements on the above described Tract of Land at the time of the Survey above mentioned were two Log dwelling houses, a Log stable and Barn, about half of the Land cleared including an Orchard &c., rendering it an actual personal resident Settlement with a manifest intention of making it a place of abode and means of supporting a family
