



By virtue of a Warrant dated the 1st July 1815. surveyed the 26 & 27 June 1816 to John Winter the above described tract of Land situate in lower Mount Bethel township Northampton County containing nineteen acres and the allowance of six p Cent &c^a.

There is a good improvement on the above land about 13 acres cleared on which grain of all sorts has been repeatedly raised ever since the year 1807. a good house is erected thereon and John Winters with his family resides therein
