



A Draught of a Tract of Land situate on Sugar Run adjoining land surveyed to John Williams in the Township of Asylum Bradford County containing Four hundred and Fifty three acres and One hundred and thirteen perches and allowance of Six per Cent for Roads said to have been surveyed in <sup>the year</sup> 1793 to George Williams in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 13<sup>th</sup> day of August 1792 by Jacob Hart an assistant to Joseph d. Wallace late Deputy Surveyor the out lines of four tract of land of which the above named <sup>is one</sup> appear to have been made about that time. Examined on the ground & Resurveyed the 3<sup>d</sup> day of July 1816 in pursuance of the ~~the~~ said Warrant of George Williams by Jonathan Stevens D.S.
