A Draught of a tract of land situate on Sugar Run adjoining land surveyed to William Williams in the Township of Asylum Bradford County containing Four hundred and five acres and One hundred and fifteen perches and allowance of Six per Cent for roads. Said to have been originally surveyed in the year 1793 to John Williams in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 13th day of August 1792 by Jacob Hart an assistant to Joseph J. Wallace late Deputy Surveyor.

The out lines of four tracts of land of which the above named is one, appear to have been made about that time. Examined on the ground and Resurveyed the 2^d day of July 1816 in pursuance of the said Warrant of John Williams
