



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietor dated the 12th of September Anno Dom: 1737. Was surveyed unto William Young in the Township of Hanover a Tract of Land beginning at a Spruce Tree Standing on an High Rock by Swatawro Creek Thence up ye same on the several Courses thereof 380 perches to a post Thence North East by Vacant Land 254 perches to a post Thence North West by Vacant Land 150 perches to a small Black Oak Thence South West by Vacant Land 60 perches to ye place of Beginning Containing Two hundred and Thirty acres beside the allowance of Six p Cent for Roads
