



In pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property bearing date the 16th day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3^d day of July 1772 for Elias Younkman on a certain Lot of Ground situate in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a general Plan of 5^d Town Number Twenty six. Containing in Breadth East and West on the South side of Shamokin Street Sixty feet and in Length North and South Two hundred and thirty feet. Bounded Northward by Shamokin Street. Eastward by Lot Number Twenty seven. Southward by Barberry Alley and Westward by Lot Number Twenty five. Returned into the Secretary's Office the 25th day of March 1776 for Elias Younkman by Warrant dated the 20th of March 1776

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this eighth day of August 1907
