



Situate in York township in the County of York Containing as above set forth 106<sup>as</sup> 137 perches and allowance. It being part of a Larger Tract of 216<sup>as</sup> 62<sup>ps</sup> & allowance of Land which was Originally surveyed by William Matthews late D.S. on the 24<sup>th</sup> of the 12<sup>th</sup> Month 1766 in pursuance of a Warrant for 200<sup>as</sup> granted to Herman Yunkers (Alias Yunker) bearing date the first day of December Anno Domini 1766 And — Resurveyed and divided off from the said Larger Tract of Land on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of April A.D. 1800 at the request of Adam Lever the present owner who desired the same to be returned for Confirmation — the 28<sup>th</sup> day of February A.D. 1811 per Jacob Spangler D.S. To Andrew Porter Esq<sup>r</sup> Surveyor General. Lancaster Pa.
