



A Draught of a Tract of Land called Springfield situate on the south East side of the Frankstown Branch of Juniata— about a mile and a half above the mouth of Little Juniata— bounded on the North-West by Juniata— on the South West by a survey made for Baynton & Co. in the name of George Croghan Esq^r and on the South and East by the Warrior Ridge including a large Spring in Barre Township in the County of Bedford containing Thirty One acres and an half and the usual allowance of six p Cent for roads &c. Surveyed the fourth day of June 1774 for John Mitchell in pursuance of a Warrant granted to him the tenth day of February in the same year. by
